- Commit to attend all training sessions in participating technical training institutions in their county of residence
- Contribute Ksh 2,000 towards the school fees. This is payable to the training institution upon receiving official communication from KCB Foundation on award of the scholarship
- Must fulfill the criteria and be within one of the three categories (Business Owner, Apprentice or Skiller)
